Multiple Measures

Students with an un-weighted high school GPA of 2.6 or higher & meet other college ready requirements will not need to take developmental courses

High school seniors are encouraged to seek out this waiver once their mid-year grades are posted.

Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA)

Statewide agreement governing the transfer of credits between NC community colleges & NC public universities. This will ensure CPCC classes will transfer seamless to the college of their choice.

Financial Aid & Scholarships

Last year, CPCC provided 38 million dollars in funding for students to attend college
This includes PELL grants & scholarships.
